Dear Madam Executive Director:

Re: Complaint against Head of Procuring Entity/Superintendent of Gbarpolu County

I am herewith submitting this letter in replacement of the one sent earlier on yesterday, April 8, 2013. This resubmission has become necessary due to omitting of a material fact in my earlier documents. This submission constitutes my appeal for review of my complaint of March 18, 2013 in which I complained the Head of Procuring Entity/Superintendent of Gbarpolu County, Hon Allen Gbowee, for violations of the PPCA Revised and Amended 2010.

In compliance with PPCA Part VIII, Section 125(2), I did formally lodge the complaint with Hon. Gbowee as Head of Procuring Entity on March 18, 2013 in anticipation of a fair and just hearing in line with the Administrative Procedure Act. On the contrary, I received no redress within the statutory period allotted for such hearing.

In view of the foregoing, I therefore take this appeal to PPCC/CARP for a review of the action of Head of Procuring Entity of Gbarpolu County, Hon. Allen Gbowee, with reference to the facts and legal submission as outlined in my complaint of March 18, 2013.

I hereto attached copies of: (1) Copy of compliant filed with Hon. Gbowee as Head of Gbarpolu County Procuring Entity on March 18, 2013, and (2) Copy of the signed-on form acknowledging actual receipt of the compliant letter.

In respect of the foregoing, I pray the Commission through the CARP, to review and grant the following:

- (a) Review the procurement proceeding and tendering process leading to the entering into of the illegal contracts with the **Renwal Liberia Limited** for the Layout of Bopolu City and contract for Electrification of Bopolu City;
- (b) Hear, determine and declare whether or not the cited provisions of the PPCA were violated;
- (c) Cancel, or cause to be cancelled, these voidable contracts (entered into in violation of the PPCA); and
- (d) Declare such further rights and remedies that the complainant is entitled as enshrined in the PPCA and as a matter of law and equity.
