INVITATION TO BID (IFB)

- 1. The Ministry of Mines and Energy (MME) was established by an act of legislature to administer all activities related to mineral, water and energy resource exploration, coordination and development in the Republic of Liberia.
- 2. The Ministry of Mines and Energy (MME) has received budgetary allocation for Fiscal Year 2024 and intends to apply part of it towards the Procurement of goods and services in separate contract packages as indicated below.
- 3. The Ministry now invites sealed bids from eligible and registered bidders for the procurement of these goods and services for Fiscal Year 2024.
- 4. Bidding will be conducted through the National Competitive Bidding (NCB) Method as enshrined in the Public Procurement and Concession Act (PPCA) as amended and restated in 2010.
