**RE: Publication of Notice of Complaint**

The Public Procurement and Concessions Commission (PPCC) hereby notifies bidders that participated in the National Elections Commission, (NEC) procurement for the Elections Prepacked Materials for the Special Senatorial Election to be held on April 22, 2025, that a Complaint/Request for Review has been filed by M-Tosh Prints Media, Inc., with the PPCC in keeping with **Section 125.1 (a)(b) of the Public Procurement and Concessions (2010) Act.**

In its complaint, M-Tosh Prints Media, Inc, alleges that the NEC violated **Part I, (d)(e)(f) &(g), Sections 55 and 131.1(a)&(b)** respectively, of the **PPCC (2010) Act.** M-Tosh Prints Media, Inc. further avers that NEC's action to exclude it from participating in the bidding process for the Nimba County Special Senatorial Election has disadvantaged and denied it the right to explore and participate in a business opportunity for which it is qualified under the laws of Liberia.

In view of the above, M-Tosh Prints Media, Inc, has filed this action, praying for the reconstitution of the bid evaluation panel.

Other participating bidders who may be affected by the resolution of this complaint, are requested to file their notice of appearance with the Complaint Appeals and Review Panel (CARP) within seven (7) days, upon publication of this Notice by the Commission, declaring an interest to appear at the hearing in keeping with Section 126(9).
