Subj: REQUEST FOR NO OBJECTION TO SINGLE SOURCE CICA MOTORS FOR THE SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF THREE SUV VEHICLES FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2024

We present our compliments and wish to acknowledge receipt of your communication which sought the approval of the Commission for the Liberia Civil Aviation Authority's request for "No Objection" to single source CICA Motors Incorporated for the supply and delivery of three Suv Vehicles with no estimated cost indicated.

The Commission upon thorough review of your request highlights the following:

- LCAA did not submit documents justifying the single source requests as required by Section .55 of the FPCA.
- LCAA did not submit evidence of funding availability as required by Section 72 of the PPCA of 2010.
- LCAA did not submit a procurement plan as required by Section 40 of the PPCA
- The LCAA did not also submit price quotation, legal qualification requirements, and draft contract.

From the above-mentioned, the Commission Cannot grant the Entity's request for "No Objection" to single source CICA Motors Incorporated for the supply and delivery of three SUV vehicles with no estimated cost indicated. Therefore, the Commission requests that the LCAA address the query by resubmitting the indicated documents.

The Public Procurement and Concessions Commission admonishes and deems it a priority that you remain in compliance with the PPCA, 2010, as we jointly aspire to achieve transparency, accountability, fairness, equality, and ultimately public confidence in our procurement and concessions processes.

The Commission should therefore requests the entity to submit it annual procurement plan for approval.

RE: REQUEST FOR NO OBJECTION TO SINGLE SOURCE PROCUREMENT OF THREE (3) SUVS

Dear Honorable Johnson,

This letter is to formally request the Public Procurement and Concessions Commission (PPCC) no objection to the Liberia Civil Aviation Authority (LCAA) use of a single-source procurement method for the acquisition of three (3) SUVs.

We request the use of the single-source method due to the following reasons:

• Specialized Requirements: The SUVs we require must meet specific operational demands for the daily commute from Monrovia to RIA and other rural airstrips around the country. These include four-wheel drive and other off-road capabilities critical for ensuring the safety and efficiency of our management team. We have conducted market research and determined that only Cica Motors Liberia Incorporated, UN Drive, Sayon Town and United Motors Company (UMC) in Via Town, Monrovia can provide SUVs that meet all these essential criteria.

Due to the time-sensitive nature of this requirement, a competitive bidding process would cause a significant delay in acquiring the necessary vehicles, potentially jeopardizing our operations and stalling movements across our aviation sector.
