Subj: REQUEST FOR 'NO OBJECTION" TO SOLE SOURCE THE FARMINGTON HOTEL FOR THE PROVISION OF ACCOMODATION FOR WEEKLONG TRAINING WITH THE SWEDISH TAX AGENCY (STA) FOR FISCAL YEAR 2024

We present our compliments and wish to acknowledge receipt of your communication which sought the approval of the Commission for the Liberia Revenue Authority request to sole source the Farmington Hotel Facility for the provision of accommodation for a weeklong training with the Swedish Tax Agency (STA) at an estimated cost of US\$ 33,720.00 (Thirty-Three Thousand Seven Hundred Twenty United States Dollars) for Fiscal Year 2024.

The Commission upon thorough review of your request highlights the following issues:

- That the LRA request is consistent with Section 55 (d) of the PPCA.
- That considering the LRA's justification, it is not advisable to conduct a competitive procurement process in the face of the urgency stated in the LRA's transmittal letter.

From the above indicated, the Commission <u>hereby</u> grants the Liberia Revenue Authority's request to sole source the Farmington Hotel Facility for the provision of accommodation for a weeklong training with the Swedish Tax Agency (STA) at an estimated cost of *US\$* 33,720.00 (*Thirty-Three Thousand Seven Hundred Twenty United States Dollars*) for Fiscal Year 2024.

The Public Procurement and Concessions Commission admonishes and deems it a priority that you remain in compliance with the PPCA, 2010, as we jointly aspire to achieve transparency, accountability, fairness, equality and ultimately public confidence in our procurement and concessions processes.
