Dear Hon. Johnson:

Re: Request for "No Objection" to Employ the Sole Source Method for the Supply of Building Materials for Renovation on BWI Campus

I present my compliments and write to inform you that the Booker Washington Institute is about to implement renovation work on three buildings on its campus. Due to the delay in sourcing resources and the urgency for the renovation work, the Booker Washington Institute is requesting a "NO OBJECTION" to employ the Sole Source Procurement Method for the Supply of needed building materials. Section 55(d) of the PPCA permits entities to employ the Sole Source Procurement Method in the following circumstances: "In cases of extreme urgency, provided that the circumstances which gave rise to the urgency were neither foreseeable by the Procuring Entity nor the result of dilatory conduct on its part."

This was certainly not due to 'dilatory conduct'. The initial budget ceiling sent to BWI had no Special Project in it but following the passage US\$200,000.00 was placed in it for Special Project. The selection of priorities, development of detailed technical drawing and Bill of Quantity (BOQ) among others, took up time to complete.

BWI intends to award the contract for the supply of the build materials, valued at **one hundred thirty-eight thousand (US\$138,000.00) United States Dollars** for the renovation of a dormitory, Automotive Department and Principal's building to Building Materials Center (BMC) as an extension of the just ended supply of building Materials Contract. BMC has successfully completed the supply of building materials worth over two hundred four thousand to BWI under a prefinancing condition, proving that it has the capacity to supply the same quality and standard of building materials under similar condition.

Your timely response will be appreciated as we endeavor to remain compliant with the Public Procurement & Concession Act of Liberia.




