

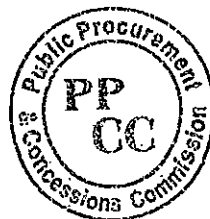

Subj: **REQUEST FOR "OBJECTION" TO AWARD CONTRACT TO PETRO TRADE FOR THE SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF PETROLEUM PRODUCTS**

We present our compliments and wish to acknowledge receipt of your communication dated March 7, 2025, which sought the approval of the Commission for the House of Representative (HOR) to award contract to Petro Trade for the supply and delivery of petroleum products at an estimated cost of three million five hundred eighty-four thousand three hundred thirty-five United States Dollars and ninety-four cents (US \$3,584,335.94).

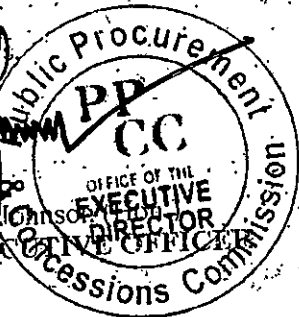
The Commission upon thorough review of additional documentation submitted reveals that the HOR's response to queries raised by the Commission is consistent with section 31 of the PPCA, 2010. Therefore, the Commission hereby grants an approval to the House of Representatives (HOR) to award contract to Petro Trade for the supply of the "Goods" at the estimated cost as indicated above.

Please note that all contract which cumulative annual value exceeds the threshold of two hundred fifty United States Dollars (US\$250,000.00) must be sign by the minister responsible for Finance and attested by the Minister Responsible for Justice. **The Commission requires that you kindly forward copies of all stipulated contracts upon signing so as to update our records.**

The Public Procurement and Concessions Commission admonishes and deems it a priority that you remain in compliance with the PPCA, 2010, as we jointly aspire to achieve transparency, accountability, fairness, equality and ultimately public confidence in our procurement and concessions processes.

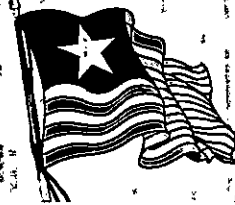
