Opening Prayers:

In line with the agenda, opening prayer was offered by Dr. Stepney.

Welcome Remarks:

Dr. Birch briefly welcome the Committee members and encourage everyone to focus and make informed decision. Dr. Birch further acknowledged the efforts of the Bid Evaluation Panel (BEP) and thank them for the hard work. On that note, Dr. Birch, called the meeting to order at about 12:04PM.

Background:

In alignment with the Public Sector Investment Program and in compliance with the Amended and Restated Public Procurement and Concession Act of 2010, JFK Medical Center initiated a **Restricted Bidding** process. An invitation to bid was extended to six (6) eligible solar providers:





- 1. Bounceband Energy
- 2. Enersource Inc
- 3. Bermuda Inc
- 4. Primevantage Holding Inc
- 5. Jayee Supplies and Services
- 6. Office Express

Of these, three (3) companies submitted sealed and signed bids by the submission deadline:

- Bounceband Energy US\$ 366,240.00
 - Enersource Inc US\$ 310,033.00
 - Bermuda Inc US\$ 877,800.00

The Bid Evaluation Panel conducted assessments based on the following criteria:

- **Preliminary Examination**
- Commercial Responsiveness
- Technical Responsiveness
- Post-Qualification Assessment

All three bidders passed each stage of the evaluation. Furthermore, physical verification and due diligence were conducted for all bidders. Upon comprehensive review, the Evaluation Panel recommended **Enersource Inc** as the lowest responsive evaluated bidder.

The Procurement Committee reviewed the full report of the Evaluation Panel and submissions taking into consideration the following:

- · Cost-effectiveness of Enersource Inc's proposal
- Technical capability and previous project performance
- Alignment with JFK's operational needs and energy sustainability goals

There were no objections raised by any committee member regarding the recommendation after the review. Based on the above-mentioned considerations, the Committee unanimously accepted and approved the recommendation to award contract to Enersource Inc.

On that noted, the Presiding Dr. Birch, thank the committee members for the time spent. At about 1:31 PM, a motion was filed for adjournment of the meeting by Dr. Tamba and was seconded by Dr. Stepney. This brought the meeting to a close.
