


Subject: RECEIPT AND APPROVAL OF THE LIBERIA NATIONAL POLICE SPECIAL OPERATIONS PROCUREMENT PLAN AND THE USE OF SOLE SOURCE FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025.

We present compliments and wish to acknowledge receipt of your letter which sought the approval of the Commission for the Liberia National Police submission of its Special Operations Procurement Plan and the use of the Sole Source method of procurement. The Commission has received and approves the LNP Special Operations Procurement Plan for Fiscal Year 2025 in accordance with Section 40 (3) of the PPCA, 2010, and informs the LNP that this Procurement Plan will be duly forwarded to the Ministry of Finance and Development Planning (MFDP), and that the MFDP will process allotments in keeping with the approved Procurement Plans, Additionally, the Commission grants a "No Objection" for the LNP to sole source MATELCO INC. for the procurement of Non-Lethal Weapons in the amount of US\$800,000.00.

The Commission counsels that you observe Section 40(5) of the PPCA, 2010 which states "each Procuring Entity, shall, on a quarterly basis and whenever it becomes necessary, review and update its procurement plans and notify the Commission in writing and the Minister of Finance of any material changes in its plan. An updated procurement plan shall accompany said notice to the Commission."

Please note that an approval of a method on the procurement plan is deemed as the Commission's full approval, and as such, a Procuring Entity will not be required to request the use of said approved method again.

The Public Procurement and Concessions Commission admonishes and deems it a priority that you remain **primarily** in compliance with the PPCA, 2010, as we jointly aspire to achieve transparency, accountability, fairness, equality and ultimately public confidence in our procurement and concessions processes.

Ref: Requesting to Single Source

Dear Hon. Johnson:

In our ongoing efforts to enhance the effectiveness of our operations, the Liberia National Police (LNP) intend to acquire non-lethal weapons from the Special Operation Services allotment for the fiscal year 2025. This procurement is intended to enhance our ability to manage civil disturbances, thereby mitigating the necessity for the use of lethal force.

To this end, we hereby request the Public Procurement & Concessions Commission's approval to single-source Matelco Inc. for the procurement of Non-Lethal Weapons in the amount of US\$800,000.00 (Eight Hundred Thousand United States Dollars).

This request is in compliance with Section 55(d&e) of the PPCC Act, which states that "Public procurement by means of the sole source procurement method is permitted " In cases of extreme urgency, provided that the circumstances which gave rise to the urgency were neither foreseeable by the Procuring Entity nor the result of dilatory conduct on its part; or only when the services require that a particular consultant be selected due to his or her unique qualifications, or when it is indispensable to continue with the same consultant".

In this case, the aforementioned supplies from Matelco Inc. meet the requirements of the LNP as outlined in Sections 55(d) and (e) of the PPCC Act of 2010.
