

Subj: RECEIPT AND APPROVAL OF ANNUAL PROCUREMENT PLAN AND REQUEST FOR NO OBJECTION TO SINGLE-SOURCE SMART SYSTEMS FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF DIGITAL TRAFFIC TICKET ISSUANCE SYSTEM AND AMERICAN UNDERWRITERS GROUP (AUG) FOR VEHICLE INSURANCE SERVICES FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2025

We present our compliments and wish to acknowledge receipt of your communication for the Commission approval of the Liberia National Police (LNP) request as indicated above.

Upon review of the documentation provided, the Commission wishes to note the following observations:

- The Liberia National Police (LNP) submitted a comprehensive package including its cover letter, approved procurement and cash plans, Smart Systems' proposal and quotation, relevant legal documentation, and a draft contract. In support of its request, the LNP indicated that Smart Systems, the proposed service provider, had been contracted during the previous fiscal year and had successfully implemented a Technical Security Network Services System, an assignment similar in scope to the current request. The prior engagement was reviewed and approved by the Commission. Accordingly, the LNP considers it both operationally and technically prudent to continue with the same vendor to expand the existing infrastructure. This request is made according to Section 55 (e) of the Public Procurement and Concessions Act (PPCA) of 2010.
- The Liberia National Police (LNP) further submitted a cover letter along with supporting legal documentation, including a valid Tax Clearance Certificate, Business Registration Certificate, PPCC Vendor Registration Certificate, and other relevant credentials. Additionally, the submission included the service provider's quotation and a draft contract in favor of American Underwriters Group (AUG). As justification for the request, the LNP invokes Section 55(d) of the Public Procurement and Concessions Act (PPCA) of 2010, citing the urgency of the procurement need.

From the above findings, the Commission herewith grants the Liberia National Police's No Objection to single source SMART SYSTEMS for the development of a digital traffic ticket issuance system at an estimated cost of US\$ 90,000.00 (Ninety-Thousand United States Dollars), and American Underwriters Group (AUG) for the provision of vehicle insurance services at an estimated cost of US\$ 100,000.00 (One Hundred Thousand United States Dollars) for fiscal the year 2025



We write to seek the Commission's approval for an extension of services previously rendered by Smart System Intelligence At Work, the firm that successfully constructed a Technical Security Network ICT Services System for the Liberia National Police (LNP).

The initial engagement, which received prior endorsement, has significantly enhanced our investigative capabilities in the areas of cybercrime prevention and internal administrative operations.
