Subject: "NO OBJECTION" TO USE THE SOLE SOURCE METHOD OF PROCUREMENT TO AWARD CONTRACT FRAMEWORK CONTRACT TO DUTCH HEALTH BV FOR THE SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF TWENTY-TWO (22) SPECIALIZED POLICE VEHICLES

We present our compliments and wish to acknowledge receipt of your letter dated July 24, 2025, which sought the approval of the Commission for the Liberia National Police (LNP) to use the Sole Source Method of Procurement to award framework contract to Dutch Health BV for the supply and delivery of twenty-two (22) specialized Police vehicles ("the Goods") at an estimated amount of one million United States Dollars (US \$1,000,000.00).

The Commission notes your assertions and wish to inform you that the intent of Liberia National Police (LNP) to use the Sole Source method of procurement to award contract to Dutch Health BV for the supply and delivery of the "Goods" as indicated above, is in compliance with Section 55the PPCA, 2010, and thus the Commission hereby grants an approval for the LNP proceed to sign framework agreement with Dutch Health BV for an amount not to exceed one million United States Dollars (US \$1,000,000.00).

Kindly be reminded that all contracts which cumulative annual value exceeds the threshold of US\$250,000.00 must be signed by the Minister responsible for Finance and attested to by the Minister responsible for Justice. The Commission requires that you kindly forward copies of all stipulated contracts upon signing so as to update our records.

However, the Commission advises that the Liberia National Police ensures that the recommended bidder Dutch Health BV be enlisted on the PPCC's Vendor Registry platform. Additionally, the LNP should kindly ensure delivery, inspection and acceptance of the initial eleven fleet of vehicles prior to contract award of the remaining twenty-two (22).

The Public Procurement and Concessions Commission admonishes and deems it a priority that you remain in compliance with the PPCA, 2010, as we jointly aspire to achieve transparency, accountability, fairness, equality and ultimately public confidence in our procurement and concessions processes.

Ref. Request for No Objection to enter into Framework Agreement/Contract

Dear Hon. Johnson:

We present our compliments and write to inform you that the Liberia National Police is intending to single-source Dutch Health for the procurement of a specialized police vehicle. In 2024, we entered into a Contract to procure 30 vehicles from Dutch Health, out of which the Ministry of Finance and Development Planning was able to pay US\$549,350.00 to Dutch Health on behalf of LNP for 11 vehicles as per the Contract.

As per the 2024 Contract, the Ministry of Finance and Development Planning in this 2025 fiscal year has appropriated the balance of **US\$1,000,000.00** to LNP towards the execution and completion of the 2024 Vehicle Procurement Contract. The Liberia National Police, therefore, requests "No Objection" from the Commission of its intent to enter into contracts with Dutch Health through the Sole Source Procurement Method for the procurement and supply of these specialized vehicles to the Liberia National Police, as was initiated in the 2024 fiscal.

This request complies with Section 31, which states that, except in the case of an emergency and with the prior approval of the Commission, the Procurement Committee shall deliver to the Commission a notice of intent to award a contract exceeding the Thresholds as established by Regulations promulgated by the Commission. No Procuring Entity shall enter into a procurement contract above the Thresholds established by Regulations promulgated by the Commission unless a minimum of fourteen (14) days have lapsed since the notification of intent to award a contract was delivered to the Commission. The Commission shall cause a notice of intent to award a contract whose contract price exceeds the Thresholds in the Regulation to be published within two (2) business days of receipt of such notice. A Procuring Entity may award a contract whose contract price is less than the Thresholds in the Regulation without notice to the Commission and passage of a minimum of fourteen (14) days as provided in this subsection (1).

The Commission may request the Procuring Entity to furnish supporting documentation demonstrating compliance with the provisions of this Act.
