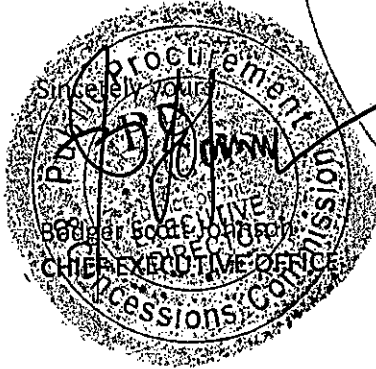

Therefore, I kindly request your **No Objection to extend** the contracts of the following vendors in the attached matrix to the end of first quarter of FY-2025 (March 2025).

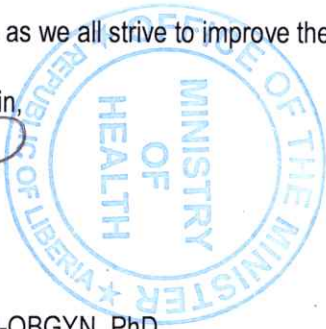
Our request is contingent upon Part V; section 55(1)e
