We present our compliments and wish to acknowledge receipt of your communication requesting the Commission's approval for the Ministry of Posts and Telecommunications request as indicated above.


The Commission upon a thorough review of your documentation submitted is pleased to highlight the following:

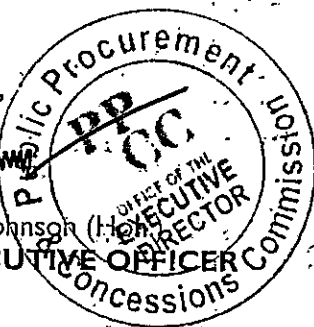
- ❖ **CICA Motors** was awarded Lot #3 of the Restricted bidding (RB) vehicle process to supply two (2) **Toyota Land Cruiser Prado** to the Ministry. According to your assertion, one of the vehicles was supply and delivered consistent with the specified requirements. However, due to the initial vehicle being out of stock, CICA Motors has requested to offer an alternative for the second vehicle.
- ❖ Further review also shows that based on the quotation submitted for both vehicles, the Toyota Fortuner is of high specification, and price. Considering the circumstances emanating from the Vendor's failure to provide the specified vehicle, CICA Motors is offering the Toyota Fortuner for the same amount as the Toyota Land Cruiser Prado which is **US\$ 41,000.00 (Forty-One Thousand United States Dollars)**

From the above findings mentioned, the Commission request that the Ministry of Posts and Telecommunications assess the proposed alternative to ensure it is fit for purpose and that it meets the required standards (specification), performance, and functionality before acceptance.

The Public Procurement and Concessions Commission admonishes and deems it a priority that you remain compliant with the PPCA, 2010, as we jointly aspire to achieve transparency, accountability, fairness, equality, and ultimately public confidence in our procurement and concessions processes.

I present my compliments, and write to inform you that the Ministry received funding from the 2024 National Budget to purchase vehicles for Deputy, Assistant Ministers, workers and operational activities. We are grateful to you for the approval of the Ministry's 2024 Procurement Plan.

The bid for two Toyota Land Cruiser PRADO for Deputy Ministers for Administration and Technical Services, Urban Cruiser for Assistant Ministers, and one operational vehicle was won by CFAO Mobility formerly CICA Motors. Also, the bid for the three workers' vehicles and the Deputy Minister for Operations was won by Prestige Motors.

However, CFAO Mobility, formerly CICA Motors has informed us that due to the end of stock of the Toyota Land Cruiser PRADO, they are offering the All-New Toyota Fortuner with the same price in place of the Toyota Land Cruiser PRADO while it is understood that the All-New Toyota Fortuner price is higher than the Toyota Land Cruiser PRADO.

In view of the above, we are seeking your approval.
