Subject: PPCC RESPONSE: REQUEST FOR "NO OBJECTION" FOR THE MINISTRY OF TRANSPORT TO AWARD CONTRACT TO WORK WELL CONSTRUCTION COMPANY FOR THE PROCUREMENT AND INSTALLATION OF ROAD STRIPPING ON THE HARBEL TO GRAND BASSA CORRIDORS – YEAR 2025

We present our compliments and wish to acknowledge receipt of your letter which sought the approval of the Commission for the Ministry of Transport (MOT) to award a contract to Well Construction Company for road stripping works on the Harbel to Grand Bassa Corridors, for an estimated cost of one million seventy-five thousand United States Dollars (US\$1,075,000.00).

The Commission, upon review of your submissions, highlights the following:

- That the MOT submitted (Hard copies) including: bid documents, bid evaluation report, procurement committee meeting minutes, bid opening minutes, draft contract, etc.;
- That the MOT employed the National Competitive Bidding and three (3) bids were received: (Work Well Construction, Magnificent Group, and Conex Liberia);
- That the Commission's review shows that both Magnificent Group of Companies and Champion Designs and Computer Accessories did not comply with pre-determine criteria set forth in the MOT's bid document;
- That Work Well Construction was deemed the most responsive for the preliminary and technical stages of the evaluation, as per the MOT BEP's Report and the Commission's review.

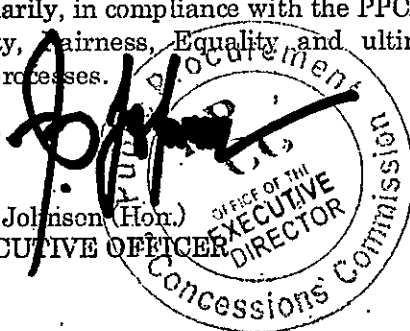
The Commission, upon overall review and scrutiny of your submission renders "No Objection" for the Ministry of Transport (MOT) to award a contract to Well Construction Company for road stripping works on the Harbel to Grand Bassa Corridors, for an estimated cost of one million seventy-five thousand United States Dollars (US\$1,075,000.00).


