We present our compliments and wish to acknowledge receipt of your letter which sought the approval of the Commission for the Ministry of Transport (MOT) to award a contract to Well Construction Company for road stripping works on the Harbel to Grand Bassa Corridors, for an estimated cost of one million seventy-five thousand United States Dollars (US\$1.075,000.00).

- That Work Well Construction was deemed the most responsive for the preliminary and technical stages of the evaluation, as per the MOT BEP's Report and the Commission's review.

The Commission, upon overall review and scrutiny of your submission renders "No Objection" for the Ministry of Transport (MOT) to award a contract to Well Construction Company for road stripping works on the Harbel to Grand Bassa Corridors, for an estimated cost of one million seventy-five thousand United States Dollars (US\$1.075,000.00).

Kindly be reminded that all contracts which cumulative annual value exceeds the threshold of US\$250,000.00 must be signed by the Minister responsible for Finance and attested to by the Minister responsible for Justice.

The Public Procurement and Concessions Commission admonishes and deems it a priority that you remain, primarily, in compliance with the PPCA, 2010, as we jointly aspire to achieve Transparency, Accountability, Pairness, Equality and ultimately public confidence in our procurement and concessions processes.
