Re: Publication of Notice of Complaint

The Public Procurement and Concessions Commission (PPCC) hereby notifies bidders who participated in the National Social Security & Welfare Corporation's (NASSCORP) procurement proceedings for the construction of a New NASSCORP Administrative Headquarters referenced **IFB No.: NASSCORP/ICB/004/13/14**, that a complaint dated November 10, 2014, has been filed with the Head/Director-General of NASSCORP in compliance with **Part VIII, Section 125 (2) of the Public Procurement & Concessions Act, 2010 (PPCA, 2010)**, and a copy filed with the PPCC.


The Complaint alleges unfair treatment in the evaluation of bids by wrongfully declaring its bid as "non-responsive" based on a report submitted by the Bid Evaluation Panel (BEP), which illegally and unfairly denied it the award of the contract in violation of the PPCA, 2010.

This Notice is being issued pursuant to **Part VIII, Section 128, Subsection (1)(a)&(b) of the PPCA, 2010**, which provides: "On receipt by the Commission of a copy of a complaint timely filed with a Procuring or Concession Entity under subsection (2) of Section 125 of this Act, or a request for decision or appeal timely filed under subsection (2) of Section 126 of this Act, the Commission shall promptly cause a notice of such filing to be published within two (2) business days of its receipt. The notice must identify the procurement or concession process with respect to which the claim is made, the complainant and the relevant Procuring or Concession Entity, and must set forth a short statement of the complainant's claim."

The purpose of this Notice is to notify other known or prospective bidders who may be affected by the resolution of a complaint to, in the case of a request for decision or appeal timely filed under subsection (2) of Section 126 of this Act, file a notice of appearance with the Complaints, Appeals and Review Panel within seven days of the publication of this Notice by the Commission, declaring an interest to appear at the hearing in keeping with Section 126 (9).
