Subject: "NO OBJECTION" TO USE FRAMEWORK CONTRACT AGREEMENT TO AWARD CONTRACT TO SUPER PETROLEUM INCORPORATED FOR THE SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF PETROLEUM PRODUCTS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2019/2020

We present our compliments and wish to acknowledge receipt of your letter which sought the approval of the Commission for the **Honorable House of Representatives** to award framework contract to Super Petroleum Inc. (Diesel in Coupons) for the supply and delivery of petroleum products ("the Goods") for an estimated monthly amount not to exceed two hundred thirty six thousand one hundred ten United States Dollars nine cents (**US\$236,110.09**) and (Gasoline in Coupons) for the supply and delivery of petroleum products ("the Goods") for an estimated monthly amount not to exceed thirty-five thousand two hundred one United States Dollar seventy two cents (**US\$35,201.72**).

The Commission notes your assertions and relying on your assurances, interposes "no objection" for the Honorable House of Representatives to use the Restricted Bidding Method of procurement to award contract to Super Petroleum Inc. for the supplies of the goods as indicated above consistent with **Section 50** (a) and 51 sub-section (1) of the PPCA.

Kindly be reminded that all contracts which cumulative annual value exceeds the threshold of US\$250,000.00 must be signed by the Minister responsible for Finance and attested to by the Minister responsible for Justice.

The Public Procurement and Concessions Commission admonishes and deems it a priority that you remain, **primarily**, in compliance with the PPCA, 2010, as we jointly aspire to achieve Transparency, Accountability, Fairness, Equality and ultimately public confidence in our procurement and concessions processes.
