Subject: **"NO OBJECTION" TO USE FRAMEWORK CONTRACT AGREEMENT TO AWARD CONTRACT TO SUPER PETROLEUM FOR THE SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF PETROLEUM PRODUCTS (DIESEL/GASOLINE) - FISCAL YEAR 2022**

We present our compliments and wish to acknowledge receipt of your letter which sought the approval of the Commission for the **House of Representatives (HOR)** to award a framework contract to Super Petroleum for the supply and delivery of petroleum products in the amount of three million two hundred sixty-seven thousand three hundred thirty-three United States Dollars and twenty-one cents **US\$3,267,333.21**.

The Commission, upon review of your submissions, highlights the following:

- That the House of Representatives submitted (**Hard copies**) including: bid documents, bid evaluation report, procurement committee meeting minutes, bid opening minutes, etc.;
- That HOR's BEP Report indicates that four (4) companies were invited to participate in the bidding process (Aminata and Sons, Inc., Super Petroleum Corporation, Total Liberia and Petro Trade), and only one bidder responded to the invitation (Super Petroleum Corporation);
- That HOR's BEP Report shows that Super Petroleum Corporation was deemed the most responsive for the preliminary, technical and financial evaluation.

The Commission, upon overall review of your submission renders "No Objection" for the **House of Representatives** to award a framework contract to **Super Petroleum Corporation** for the supply of the goods as indicated above and in the stipulated monthly amount not to exceed two hundred seven-two thousand two hundred twenty-seven United States Dollars and seventy-seven cents **US\$272,227.77**

Kindly be reminded that all contracts which cumulative annual value exceeds the threshold of **US\$250,000.00** must be signed by the Minister responsible for Finance and attested to by the Minister responsible for Justice.

The Public Procurement and Concessions Commission admonishes and deems it a priority that you remain, **primarily**, in compliance with the PPCA, 2010, as we jointly aspire to achieve Transparency, Accountability, Fairness, Equality and ultimately public confidence in our procurement and concessions processes.
