Dear Commissioner Meres,  
We extend our compliments and bring to your attention a massive breach of PPCC laws and regulations by Hon. Rose E.Stryker, Deputy Inspector General of police for administration, Liberia National Police.

July of 2011, the administration of the Liberia National Police advertised in a major news papers a bid for procurement of uniforms and accessories.

The bid was presided over by Hon. Harry Dunn, chairman of the procurement committee, Liberia National Police.

After many days of bid evaluation, Monrovia Merchandise Mart was selected as winner and request to proceed with negotiation to procure the uniforms and accessories for delivery.

About two months of anxiously waiting to receive a local purchase order for the many items to be purchased, we received the attached copy of letter from Deputy Inspector General Stryker, indicating that the bid was canceled or it was not properly done and it was been evaluated.

Surprisingly, we had learned from sources within the Liberia National Police that in fact the procurement power had been transferred from the procurement committee and logistic Section to one Moore, a civilian employee of the Liberia National Police and non participant of the said bid had been awarded the contract to supply uniforms and accessories.


In view of the above, we seek your intervention in this matter, for we have procured a large quantity of uniforms and accessories based upon the result of the bid and authorization letter from the bidding committee of the Liberia National Police.

Accordingly, the uniforms and accessories will be arriving at the Free Port of Monrovia on January 18, 2012.
