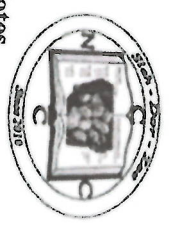

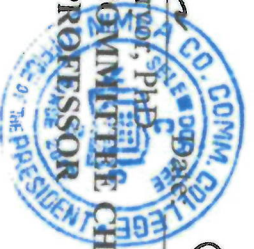

1	IFB No. NCCCC/GOL/FA/002/21	Extension of NCCC President's Office and Conference Room	This procurement plan is intended for the Extension of NCCCC President's Office and Conference Room. The sources of funding will come from Government of Liberia allocation to the college and the college internal revenue. Due to inadequate resources, we will use our Technical Vocational Education Training (TVET) Students to assist us, to extend the President's Office and Conference's Room. The entire cost of the project is USD \$5,900.11 (Five Thousand Nine Hundred and Eleven Cent United States Dollars), while we procure materials using normal PPCC's procedures. The selection method will be Request for Quotations (RFQ), to procure the construction materials.
