The **Public Procurement and Concessions Commission** through the Ministry of Finance and Development Planning (MFDP) has received financing from the World Bank toward the cost of the Public Financial Management Reforms Institutional Strengthening Project (PFMRISP), and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contract for **Supply, Installation, Configuration, Deployment and Maintenance of an Electronic Government Procurement (e-GP) System for the Government of Liberia on Software as a Service (SAAS) Model**.
2. The Public Procurement and Concessions Commission (PPCC) now invites sealed Bids from eligible Bidders for **Supply, Installation, Configuration, Deployment and Maintenance of an Electronic Government Procurement (e-GP) System for the Government of Liberia on Software as a Service (SAAS) Model**<sup>1</sup> initially to be piloted in at the PPCC and five (5) Ministries Agencies Commissions (MACs) of the Government of Liberia and subsequent rollout across all MACs.
3. Bidding will be conducted through international competitive procurement using Request for Bids (RFB) as specified in the World Bank's "Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers" July 2016 Revised November 2017, August 2018 and Revised November 2020 and is open to all eligible Bidders as defined in the Procurement Regulations.

7. All Bids must be accompanied by a Bid Security from a reputable bank in the amount of Twelve Thousand United States Dollars (\$12,000.00).
8. Attention is drawn to the Procurement Regulations requiring the Borrower to disclose information on the successful bidder's beneficial ownership, as part of the Contract Award Notice, using the Beneficial Ownership Disclosure Form as included in the bidding document.
