Subj: **REQUEST FOR NO OBJECTION TO AWARD CONTRACTS FOR THE SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF ESSENTIAL DRUGS AND MEDICAL SUPPLIES FOR FISCAL YEAR 2026**

We present our compliments and acknowledges receipt of the Ministry of Health's request seeking the Commission's **"No Objection"** to award contracts for the supply and delivery of essential drugs and medical supplies for Fiscal Year 2026.

During the initial review, it was observed that the submission did not include documentary evidence demonstrating compliance with the International Competitive Bidding (ICB) procurement process. Consequently, the Ministry was requested to submit the requisite documentation in support of the procurement proceedings. Upon receipt and comprehensive review of the additional documents submitted, the Commission observed that five (5) vendors, including two (2) foreign companies, participated in the bidding process. The total amount approved in the Ministry's Procurement Plan for this activity is **(US\$1,251,838.56). One Million Two Hundred Fifty-One Thousand Eight Hundred Thirty-Eight United States Dollars Fifty-Six Cents.**

Following a detailed evaluation of the procurement process and bid assessment reports, the Commission notes the following:

- ❖ **Neosoft Medical Konsult INC.** was found responsive to the evaluation criteria in accordance with the Standard Bid Documents for **Lot 2**;
- ❖ **Global Pharmaceutical Laboratory LTD** was found responsive for **Lot 1, Lot 4, and Lot 5**;
- ❖ **Benthol Pharmaceutical** was found responsive for **Lot 3**;
- ❖ **Ernest Chemist LTD (foreign company)** was responsive at the preliminary and technical stages but non-responsive at the financial evaluation stage, as the bid price exceeded acceptable limits; and
- ❖ **Costless Ventures (foreign company)** was responsive at the preliminary and technical stages but non-responsive at the financial evaluation stage, due to higher financial bids.

In view of the foregoing, that the procurement process was conducted in compliance with the Public Procurement and Concessions Act (PPCA), 2026, the Commission hereby grants **"No Objection"** to the Ministry of Health to award contracts as follows:

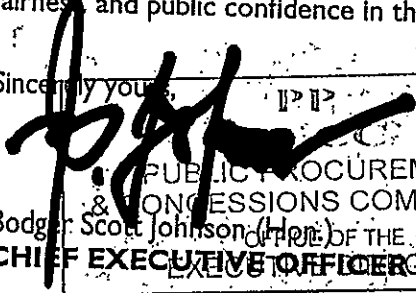
- ❖ **Neosoft Medical Konsult INC. – US\$246,050.50 (Lot 2)**
- ❖ **Global Pharmaceutical Laboratory LTD – US\$203,200.00 (Lot 1), US\$158,000.66 (Lot 4) US\$238,800.00 (Lot 5)**
- ❖ **Benthol Pharmaceutical – US\$399,987.40 (Lot 3)**

Total Contract Value: US\$1,246,038.56 below the approved amount of **US\$1,251,838.56** on the Ministry's procurement plan for Fiscal Year 2026.

This approval is granted subject to compliance with all applicable procurement laws, regulations, and contract management procedures, including proper contract execution, performance monitoring, and timely delivery of the contracted supplies.

The Public Procurement and Concessions Commission reiterates the importance of full compliance with the PPCA, 2010 and 2026, as we collectively strive to promote transparency, accountability, fairness, and public confidence in the national procurement and concessions system.

Request for No Objection to Award Contracts for the Supply and Delivery of Drugs and Medical Supplies to the Ministry of Health with Funding from Project 5993

I present my compliments and herewith request the Public Procurement Concession Commission's "No Objection" to award contracts to three (3) firms (Global Pharmaceuticals & Manufacturing Ltd, Benthol Pharmacy & Neosoft Medical Konsults) for the supply and delivery of drugs and medical Supplies to the Ministry of Health with funding from Project 5993.

For your information, the Procurement Unit of the Ministry of Health developed procurement plan for Project 5993, which was approved by the Commission. The procurement plan contained a line for the supply and delivery of drugs and medical supply using the International Competitive Bidding method.

Howbeit, the procurement process from the level of the Ministry of Health will move forward pending the Commission's No Objection for approval to award contracts to the three (3) most responsive firms for five (5) lots. Additionally, the Ministry seeks urgent attention to this matter due to the timeline for partner's funding.

Subsequently, **Lot 1, 4 & 5** are to be awarded to Global Pharmaceuticals Ltd., in the amount of **Six Hundred Five Thousand eight hundred United States Dollars sixty-six cents (605,800.66)**. Per lot, Global Pharmaceuticals award amounts to **(Lot 1-\$203,200.00, Lot 4-158,800.66 & Lot 5- 243,800.00)**, While Lot 2 will be awarded to Neosoft Medical Konsults amounts to **Two Hundred Forty-six Thousand fifty United States Dollars fifty cents (\$246,050.50)** and Benthol Pharmacy which amounts to **three hundred ninety-nine thousand nine hundred eighty-seven United States dollars forty cents (399,987.40)**.

Honorable Commissioner, the Ministry request for No Objection to award contracts to the three firms is in keeping with the Public Procurement and Concession commission act, Reliance: PPCC Act, 2010 Award of Procurement Contract, Section 65(1): *The contract shall be awarded by the Procuring Entity to the bidder that is qualified and submitted the lowest evaluated responsive bid which meets the evaluation criteria as specified in the Request for Quotation*".

Kindly note that this letter is in reference to the documents submitted earlier to help with the approval process.

Thanks for your consideration and assistance, as we strive to improve the health sector.
