Subj: **REQUEST FOR "NO OBJECTION" TO AWARD CONTRACT TO MEINHARDT MALTA PVT. LTD FOR TRANSACTION ADVISORY SERVICES FOR THE LIBERIAN AIRPORT AUTHORITY-DEVELOPMENT AND MODERNIZATION OF ROBERTS INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT.**

We present our compliments and wish to acknowledge receipt of your communication dated January 20, 2026, which sought the approval of the Commission for National Investment Commission (NIC) acting on behalf of the Inter-Ministerial Concessions Committee (IMCC) consistent with Section 78 of the PPCA, 2026, to award contract to Meinhardt Malta Pvt. Ltd for Transaction Advisory Services (Consultancy) for the Liberian Airport Authority-Development and Modernization of Roberts International Airport at an estimated cost of one million ninety-one thousand four hundred twenty United States Dollars (US\$1,091,420.00).



Ltd for Transaction Advisory Services (Consultancy) for the Liberian Airport Authority-Development and Modernization of Roberts International Airport ("the Service") at the estimated costs indicated above.

Please note that all contract which cumulative annual value exceeds the threshold of two hundred fifty United States Dollars (US\$250,000.00) must be sign by the minister responsible for Finance and attested by the Minister Responsible for Justice. **The Commission requires that you kindly forward copies of all stipulated contracts upon signing so as to update our records.**

However, the Commission advises that the NIC formally confirm the availability and adequacy of funding prior to contract signature, so as to mitigate fiscal and contractual risks and ensure that the award is executed in a manner consistent with the principles of transparency, value for money, and public financial management.

The Public Procurement and Concessions Commission admonishes and deems it a priority that you remain primarily in compliance with the PPCA, 2010, as we jointly aspire to achieve transparency, accountability, fairness, equality and completely public confidence in our procurement and concessions processes.

**Subject: Request for No Objection to Award Contract to Meinhardt Malta Pvt. Ltd for Transaction Advisory Services for the Liberian Airport Authority-Development and Modernization of Roberts International Airport**

Dear Hon. Johnson,

I present my compliments and would like to request the Public Procurement and Concessions Commission's "No Objection" for contract award to Meinhardt Malta Pvt. Ltd. For the provision of Transaction Advisory Services to the Liberian Airport Authority for the Development and Modernization of the Roberts International Airport.

Accordingly, kindly note this procurement process was conducted using the Quality and Cost-Based Selection (QCBS) methodology, which was applied with a weighting of 70% for technical quality and 30% for cost.

A two-stage procurement process was followed:

1. An open Request for Expressions of Interest (EOI) yielding 17 submissions, from which 6 top firms were shortlisted and invited to submit full proposals.
2. The Request for Proposals (RFP) was issued in August 2025, and by the October 2025 deadline, five proposals were received on time. One firm (STUDI International) declined to submit their proposal, which resulted in five (5) submissions received by the Evaluation Panel.

The five compliant proposals (Meinhardt Malta, NACO, CPCS Transcom, Modalis, and HAAB Aviation Consortium) proceeded through a rigorous technical and financial evaluation in line with the RFP criteria and the Public Procurement and Concessions Act of 2010. All of the evaluated firms obtained the minimum technical score of 70 points to qualify for financial opening.

In addition, technical scores among the finalists ranged from 76.4 to 86.4 (out of 100), reflecting varying strengths in firm experience, proposed methodology, and team qualifications. Financial proposals ranged from US\$ 1.09 million to US\$ 3.30 million, indicating a wide disparity in cost offers. The lowest cost proposal was offered by Meinhardt Malta (US\$ 1.09M), and the highest by HAAB (US\$ 3.30M).



After applying the 70/30 weighting, Meinhardt Malta achieved the highest composite score (88.8 out of 100) and the top ranking. Meinhardt's technical quality (84.0 points) combined with the lowest price yielded the best overall score. The second-ranked firm was NACO (Netherlands Airport Consultants) with a composite score of 83.5. Other firms (CPCS and Modalis) scored in the 81-82 range, and HAAB ranked last with a significantly lower composite score (63.4), due to its much higher price.

In view of the aforementioned, the Liberia Airport Authority (LAA), through the Inter-Ministerial Concessions Committee (IMCC), requests "No Objection" to award the contract to the most qualified firm in keeping with the Public Procurement and Concessions Commission's Act, Reliance: PPCC Act, 2010 Award of Procurement Contract, Section 65(1): "The contract shall be awarded by the Procuring Entity to the bidder that is qualified and submitted the lowest evaluated responsive bid which meets the evaluation criteria as specified in the Request for Quotation."

Hon. Johnson, thank you for your cooperation, and please accept the assurances of my esteem.
