Subj: **REQUEST FOR NO OBJECTION TO SINGLE SOURCE FAMILY LINE ENERGIES FOR THE SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF (1,750,000) ONE MILLION SEVEN HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND GALLONS OF HEAVY FUEL OIL (HFO) TO THE LEC BUSHROD ISLAND BULK STORAGE TANK FOR FISCAL YEAR 2026**

We present our compliments and write to acknowledge receipt of your communication requesting the Commission's **No Objection** to employ the Sole Source Procurement Method for the award of contract to Family Line Energies for the supply and delivery of One Million, Seven Hundred Fifty Thousand Gallons (**1,750,000 Gals**) of Heavy Fuel Oil (HFO) to the Liberia Electricity Corporation (LEC) Bushrod Island Bulk Storage Tanks, at a total contract price of **Five Million Five Thousand United States Dollars (US\$5,005,000.00)**.

During initial review, it was noticed that the LEC submitted a comprehensive procurement package, which included the following:

- ❖ Cover Letter
- ❖ Special Project Procurement Plan
- ❖ Explanatory Note
- ❖ Approved One-Twelfth (1/12th) Budget
- ❖ Bidder's Eligibility Documents
- ❖ Bidder's Technical and Commercial Proposal, and
- ❖ Draft Contract

During additional review, the Commission noted your justification that the LEC's current stock of Heavy Fuel Oil is critically low and insufficient to sustain operations during the dry season period from **January to May 2026**, owing to reduced water inflows at the Mount Coffee Hydro Plant. Additionally, the Commission took note of the highly competitive financial proposal submitted by **Family Line Energies**, which includes duty-free pricing and an offer to pre-finance the full delivery, thereby granting LEC a six-month payment window. The Commission further acknowledges that, pending approval of LEC's Fiscal Year 2026 budget, the Corporation intends to finance this procurement through the approved **one-twelfth (1/12th) budget** of Fiscal Year 2025.

Following an independent assessment, the Commission observed that the justification provided aligns with the provisions of **Section 55 (I) (d)** of the Amended and Restated Public Procurement and Concessions Act (PPCA), 2026, which permits sole source procurement under exceptional circumstances, including urgency and continuity of essential public services. The Commission further determined that the proposed supplier meets the eligibility and qualification requirements to deliver the required Heavy Fuel Oil.

In view of the foregoing and in the interest of ensuring uninterrupted electricity supply during the dry season period, the Commission is pleased to grant **No Objection** to the Liberia Electricity Corporation to sole source Family Line Energies in the total amount of **US\$5,005,000.00**, strictly in


accordance with **Section 55 (1) (d)** of the PPCA, 2026, and subject to full compliance with all applicable procurement laws, regulations, and contractual obligations.

The Commission, however, strongly encourages LEC to utilize the Electronic Government Procurement (e-GP) System for all future procurement activities and to conduct open and competitive procurement processes for similar acquisitions, in line with the objectives of the PPCA, 2026, to promote transparency, value for money, and accountability.

The Commission remains available to provide any technical guidance and support required to ensure compliance and operational efficiency.

The Public Procurement and Concessions Commission reiterates the importance of full compliance with the PPCA, 2010 and 2026, as we collectively strive to promote transparency, accountability, fairness, and public confidence in the national procurement and concessions system.

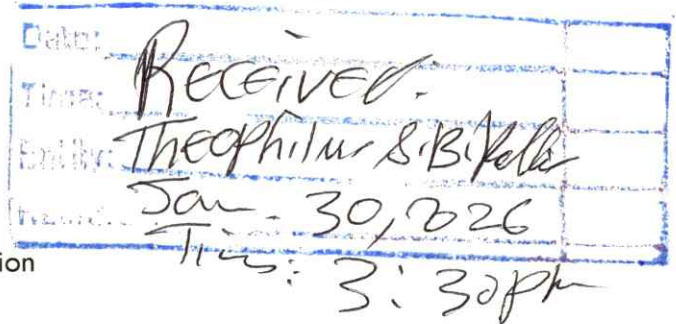

Subject: REQUEST FOR NO OBJECTION TO USE THE SOLE SOURCE METHOD OF PROCUREMENT TO AWARD A CONTRACT TO FAMILY LINE ENERGIES FOR THE SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF ONE MILLION, SEVEN HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND GALLONS (1,750,000 GALLONS) OF HEAVY FUEL OIL (HFO) TO THE LIBERIA ELECTRICITY CORPORATION BUSHROD ISLAND BULK STORAGE TANKS

We extend our sincere compliments and respectfully request the PPCC's approval to employ the Sole Source Method of Procurement for the award of a contract to Family Line Energies. This contract will ensure the urgent supply and delivery of One Million, Seven Hundred Fifty Thousand Gallons (1,750,000 gallons) of Heavy Fuel Oil (HFO) to the Liberia Electricity Corporation's Bushrod Island Bulk Storage Tanks. Presently, LEC possesses only 50,668 gallons of HFO—an amount insufficient to sustain our critical dry season operations from January 2026 through May 2026. Compounding this challenge, the anticipated low water inflows at the Mount Coffee Hydro Power Plant will severely restrict power generation, jeopardizing reliable electricity for Monrovia and surrounding communities.

To maintain a reliable power supply and prevent widespread outages, LEC must rely on its Bushrod thermal plants, which require the full 1,750,000 gallons of HFO to operate continuously. The risk is most acute in March, when water inflows are at their lowest, which could exacerbate load-shedding and further disrupt daily life and economic activity. Recognizing these risks, LEC has proactively engaged Family Line Energies, who have submitted a highly competitive financial proposal. Their offer includes a duty-free unit price of US\$2.86 per gallon and, importantly, an agreement to pre-finance the total delivery, granting LEC a six-month payment window. The supplier's commitment to deliver the entire product within three weeks of contract signing presents an extraordinary opportunity to quickly and efficiently secure our energy needs. Moreover, Family Line Energies proposes providing two essential pieces of equipment—a fuel storage tank and a dispenser—to further enhance LEC's operational capacity and resilience.

In light of these compelling circumstances, LEC urgently requests the PPCC's "NO OBJECTION" to proceed with the Sole Source Method of Procurement, awarding the contract to Family Line Energies for the full supply and delivery of One Million, Seven

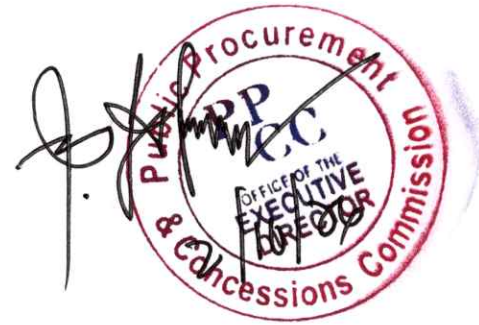
