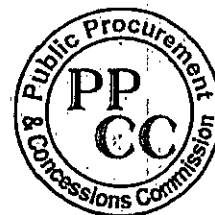

Subj: **APPROVAL OF ADDENDUM PROCUREMENT PLAN FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2025**

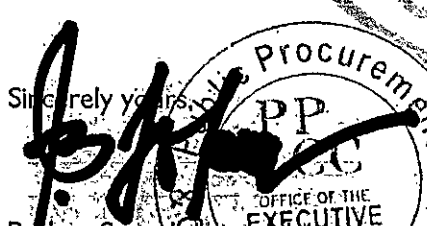

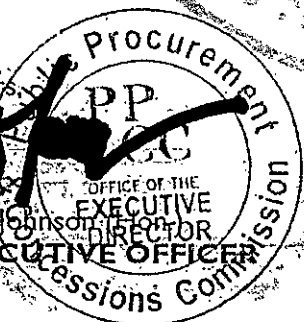

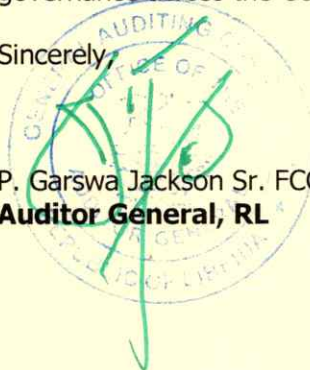

1	IFB No. GAC/SS/005/2026	PRINTING MATERIALS	The cost of US \$ 22,000.00 is derived from the budget line-item Printing, Binding & Publication as indicated in GAC's Proposed Budget FY 2026. This Contract package is intended to cover the cost of printing and installation of five (5) large banners to strategic locations in Monrovia. The banners will contain information about the AFROSAI-E Governing Board Meeting to be held in May 2026 by the General Auditing Commission. The duration for publication of the banners is two months (April – May, 2026). In line with Section 55(1)(a) of the PPC Act of 2010, we are requesting for single source because only one company (Magic Indoor & Outdoor Advertisement) has been authorized by the Monrovia City Corporation (MCC) to manage these billboards. Therefore, the need for solicitation of service providers is not necessary. The locations for publication of the billboards include the Vamoma House Overhead (4mx15m), the Gabriel Tucker Bridge Billboard (6mx4m), Boys Town Billboard (6mx4m), ELWA Junction Billboard (6mx4m) and Nigeria House Overhead (15mx4m).
2	IFB No. GAC/SS/006/2026	SECURITY GUARD SERVICE	The cost of US \$25,200.00 is drawn from the budget line-item Operational Expenses , as indicated in GAC's Proposed Budget FY 2026. This contract package is intended to cover cost for procurement of security guard services for the GAC executives. The General Auditing Commission Procurement Committee has decided to use single source method because the current security firm (MESA) was hired through a procurement process that was initiated this fiscal year (FY 2025) and is currently being implemented until December 31, 2025. As a matter of security concerns, the firm has deployed its security personnels at the various strategic locations and has gathered pertinent information relative to the protection and safety of the senior staff and executives. Section 55(1)(e) of the PPC Act of 2010 provides that "...when it is indispensable to continue with the same consultant." Therefore, the need to conduct open competitive procurement process for next fiscal year is not necessary.
