
Subj: REQUEST FOR "NO OBJECTION" TO USE THE SOLE SOURCE METHOD OF PROCUREMENT TO AWARD CONTRACT TO YAMASEC LIMITED FOR THE SUPPLY AND UPGRADE OF COAST GUARD TACTICAL, PATROL AND DIVING SYSTEM

We present our compliments and wish to acknowledge receipt of your communication dated October 28, 2025, which sought the approval of the Commission for the Ministry of National Defense (MOD) to use the sole source method of procurement to award contract to Yamasec Limited (Ltd.) for supply and upgrade of Coast Guard Tactical, Patrol and Diving System ("the Service") at an estimated cost of ninety-seven thousand one hundred United States Dollars (US \$97,100.00).

The Commission upon thorough review of your documentation submitted reveals that your request was accompanied with adequate documentation and is in keeping with section 55 (1) (d) and (e) of the PPCA, 2010. SUBJECT: REQUEST NO OBJECTION TO USE THE SOLE SOURCE METHOD OF PROCUREMENT FOR THE SUPPLY AND UPGRADE OF COAST GUARD TACTICAL, PATROL, AND DIVING SYSTEMS

I present my compliments and submit this request for your approval to use the **Sole Source** method of procurement for the urgent supply and upgrade of Liberia National Coast Guard tactical, patrol, and diving systems.

A recent operational readiness assessment conducted in collaboration with **Sea Shepherd Global** revealed critical gaps in the Coast Guard's maritime capabilities, particularly in three key areas:

1. **Tactical Boarding Team Equipment** - advanced protective and communication gear required for safe and efficient boarding operations.
2. **Patrol Vessel Propulsion Systems** – the urgent need to replace and upgrade the existing twin 225 HP Honda engines on the 27-foot Safe Boat Patrol Vessel with new Yamaha 250 HP commercial outboard engines.
3. **Self-Contained Underwater Breathing Apparatus (SCUBA) Diving Equipment** – restoration of diving systems to full operational capability to support underwater search, rescue, and recovery missions.

The absence of these systems severely limits the Coast Guard's ability to respond to maritime emergencies, participate in joint operations, and meet international operational standards for maritime security and search and rescue.

In line with Sections 55(d) and 55(e) of the Public Procurement and Concessions Act (PPCA) of 2010, as amended, Sole Source procurement may be used where the urgency or specialized nature of the procurement renders competitive methods impractical. In this case, Yamasec Ltd is the only company in Liberia with the technical and military-specific capacity to supply and install these integrated tactical, patrol, and diving systems to the required operational standards.

Engaging Yamasec Ltd., which has an established record with the Ministry for supplying specialized military materials including the custom camouflage uniforms exclusively designed for the Armed Forces of Liberia ensures quality, compatibility, and compliance with the Coast Guard's operational framework. Competitive bidding in this instance would result in unacceptable delays and jeopardize national maritime security operations.

The total cost of the project is estimated at Ninety-Seven Thousand One Hundred United States Dollars **(US\$97,100.00)**.

In view of the foregoing, the Ministry of National Defense respectfully requests the PPCC to kindly grant a "No Objection" for the use of Sole Source procurement to award this contract to Yamasec Ltd in the interest of urgency, compliance with international standards, and the public good.
