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Executive Summary

The Public Procurement and Concessions Commission (PPCC) has the core objective to achieve transparency in procedures, processes and decisions relating to procurement and concession agreements, and to ensure "Value for Money" through the economic and efficient use of public funds.

During the Fiscal Year 2019/2020 the Commission experienced some growth in the achievements of its statutory mandate and did experienced several challenges. Nevertheless, in spite of constraints faced by the Commission, it can be said that the PPCC is headed in the right direction.

During the period under review, the Compliance and Monitoring Division, a division of the PPCC along with other members of the Commission's Secretariat collaborated efforts to ensure that procurement entities, private sector actors and procurement practitioners adhered to the tenets of the 2010 Public Procurement and Concessions Act of Liberia. This report highlights their compliance with procurement planning, reporting, seeking prior approval where applicable, as well as following the required processes and procedures as laydown by law.

This report narrates the directives as outlay in the submission of annual procurement plan for approval as enshrine in Section 40 (3) of the PPCA. Therefore, during the Fiscal Year 2019/2020, out of the 146 Procuring Entities invited for the annual procurement plan hearing and requested to submit their annual procurement plans for their respective core budgets as contained in the 2019/2020 approved national budgets and the approved budgets of States Owned Enterprises (SOEs) in keeping with the aforementioned provision of the PPCA, 119 or 81.5% annual procurement plans were approved by the Commission. This means that 27 or 18.5% of the total number of PEs did not have approved procurement plans for the FY under review.

Secondly, this report covers the submission of quarterly procurement report by public procurement entities as proscribed by Section 27(g) of the PPCA. Consequently, over the course of the FY 2019/2020, only 9 or 6.1% of the total number of PEs submitted a quarterly procurement report to the Commission as required by Section 27(g) of the PPCA. This means that 136 or 93.9% of the total number of PEs did not report to the Commission on the progress or status of their respective procurement activities.

Thirdly, this compliance account also covers procurement agencies obligation to adhere to the submission of public notices of contract award as mandated by Section 37 of the PPCA. In this light, only 9 or 6.1% of the total number of PEs provided information to the Commission regarding contracts that they awarded above the stipulated thresholds as required by Section 37 of the PPCA and Section 9 of the Schedule of Threshold on Procurement Regulation No.003. By interpretation, this means that all other PEs that awarded contracts for Goods above US\$20,000, Services above US\$10,000 and Works above US\$30,000 did not provide their contract award information reports to the Commission for review and subsequent publication as required by the Act.

Additionally, for entities adhering to seeking the prior approval of the PPCC in line with Section 31 of the PPCA 2010, at least twenty-five or 17.1% of the total number of PEs sought the "Prior Approval" of the Commission to award 38 contracts for Goods, Works and Services in excess of the thresholds stipulated under Section 7 of the Schedule of Threshold (Reg. No.003).

Finally, the PPCC has endure some challenges in 2019/2020. Few of wish are:

1. Inadequate funding to run the activities of the Commission;
2. Resistance to public procurement and concession compliance by some entities;
3. Limited manpower to conduct the commission's affairs, and
4. Adequate logistics and needed tools and equipment to carry the work of the Commission.

Conclusion

Amidst the challenges confronting the Commission, the Commission was able to commence routine inspection of procurement records of some PEs during the period under review as well as update information on its 2019/2020 compliance report to include other relevant information on the performance of procurement entities in relations to the ability to adhere to public procurement compliance. Such findings are reflected in this report.

Recommendations:

- ✓ That adequate financial support is provided for the PPCC to carry out its mandate;
- ✓ That the Commission is relocated or the existing facilities of the Commission is expanded in anticipation of the migration to eProcurement
- ✓ Focus made on training and equipping Commission staff and other stakeholders with new skills and abilities to carry out their duties, and
- ✓ That special emphasis is placed on the importance of monitoring compliance through out government

Introduction

Section 5 (a) of the Amended and Restated Public Procurement Concession Act (PPCA) of 2010 mandates the Public Procurement and Concessions Commission (PPCC) to monitor compliance with the Act by all parties and persons to whom the all applies.

The adherence to the PPCA is critical to the proper utilization of funds allocated for the procurement of goods and services under the National Budget and the provision of the basic social services to citizens by the National Government.

In light of the foregoing, this report assesses the compliance of Procuring Entities (PEs) with Section 27 (g) (Submission of Quarterly Procurement Report), Section 31 (Time for Entering into Procurement Contracts), Section 37 (Public Notice of Contract Award) and Section 40 (3) respectively of the PPCA (Submission of Annual Procurement Plan for Approval) for the Fiscal Year 2019/2020

Compliance with Procurement Planning

Section 5 (a) of the Amended and Restated Public Procurement Concession Act (PPCA) of 2010 mandates the Public Procurement and Concessions Commission (PPCC) to monitor compliance with the Act by all parties and persons to whom the all applies.

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In light of the foregoing, this report assesses the compliance of Procuring Entities (PEs) with Section 27 (g) (Submission of Quarterly Procurement Report), Section 31 (Time for Entering into Procurement Contracts), Section 37 (Public Notice of Contract Award) and Section 40 (3) respectively of the PPCA (Submission of Annual Procurement Plan for Approval) for the Fiscal Year 2019/2020.

Submission Approval of Annual Procurement Plan (SECTION 40 (3) OF THE PPCA)

Section 40 (3) of the PPCA requires that after review and any revisions by the Procurement Committee, the Procurement Committee shall furnish a copy of the annual procurement plan to the Commission for approval.

During the Fiscal Year 2019/2020, out of the 146 Procuring Entities invited for the annual procurement plan hearing and requested to submit their annual procurement plans for their respective core budgets as contained in the 2019/2020 approved national budgets and the approved budgets of States Owned Enterprises (SOEs) in keeping with the aforementioned provision of the PPCA, 119 or 81.5% annual procurement plans were approved by the Commission. This means that 27 or 18.5% of the total number of PEs did not have approved procurement plans for the FY under review.

Comparing the total number of PEs of 119 with approved annual procurement plan during the 2019/2020 FY with that of the total number of PEs of 84 with approved annual procurement plan during the 2018/2019 FY, 35 or 41.6% additional PEs annual procurement plans were approved during the 2019/2020 FY.

Though having an approved procurement plan does not translate into full compliance with the PPCA, but it expresses an intention on the part of a PE to comply with the requirements of the PPCA by submitting its annual procurement plan for approval. In contrast, executing procurement activities without an approved procurement plan exposes procurement activities to flaw and mis-procurement that could result in the misappropriation, misapplication and underutilization of scarce public resources. To this end, all the entities that implemented procurement activities without an approved procurement plan put the fraction of the 2019/2020 National Budget allocated to them at risk. The listing of entities with and without approved procurement plans for the FY 2019/2020 is provided in annexure 1 of this report.

It is worthwhile to report that 38 or 26% of the total number of PEs mentioned above also submitted project procurement plans that were approved by the Commission. The Listing of entities that submitted project procurement plans is provided under annexure 2 of this report.

Submission of Quarterly Procurement Report - section 27 (g)

section 27 (g) of the pcpa requires the procurement committee (pc) of every pe to provide the commission with quarterly reports.

over the course of the fy 2019/2020, only 9 or 6.1% of the total number of pes submitted a quarterly procurement report to the commission as required by section 27 (g) of the pcpa, this means that 136 or 93.9% of the total number of pes did not report to the commission on the progress or status of their respective procurement activities. it is worth noting that the failure of pes to submit their quarterly procurement reports as required prevented the commission from

examining whether or not they conducted their procurement activities in line with the PPCA. The listing of entities that submitted and did not submit their quarterly procurement reports for the FY 2019/2020 is provided in Annexure 3 of this report.

Procuring Entities Submitting Quarterly Reports
Public Notice of Contract Award (Section 37)

Section 37 of the PPCA and section 9 of the Schedule of Threshold on Procurement Regulation No.003 require that procuring entity shall promptly furnish the commission notice of each contract awarded in which the price of the contract exceeds US\$20,000 for goods; US\$10,000 for services and US\$30,000 for works indicating the reference number used in the bidding process, the contract price, the name and address of the successful bidder, a brief description of the goods, services or work procured and the procurement method utilized in awarding the contract.

For the period under review, only 9 or 6.1% of the total number of PEs provided information to the commission regarding contracts that they awarded above the stipulated thresholds as required by section 37 of the PPCA and section 9 of the Schedule of Threshold on Procurement Regulation No.003. By interpretation, this means that all other PEs that awarded contracts for goods above US\$20,000, services above US\$10,000 and works above US\$30,000 did not provide their contract award information reports to the commission for review and subsequent publication as required by the Act.

Crucially, it needs to be noted that the failure of majority of the PEs to submit their contract award information to the commission over the years has been the main reason for which the commission has been unable to publish information regarding the number of contracts awarded, the reference number used in the bidding process, the contract price, the name and address of the successful bidder, a brief description of the goods, services or work procured and the procurement method utilized. The listing of entities that submitted their contract award information for the FY 2019/2020 is provided in Annexure 4 of this report.



"No Objection" Approvals, Queries and Rejections in F/Y 2019-2020

Time for Entering Contracts and Report to the Commission of Proposed Awards (Section 31 of the PPCA)

Except in the case of emergency and with the prior approval of the Commission, the Procurement Committee shall deliver to the Commission a notice of intent to award a contract exceeding US\$200,000 for Goods, US\$100,000 for Non Consulting Services, US\$100,000 for Consulting Services without soliciting Expression of Interest, US\$200,000 for Consulting Services following the solicitation of Expression of Interest and US\$400,000 for Works. No Procuring Entity shall enter into a procurement contract above the Thresholds establish by Regulations promulgated by the Commission unless a minimum of fourteen (14) days have lapsed since the notification of intent to award a contract was delivered to the Commission.

During the period under review, twenty-five or 17.1% of the total number of PEs sought the "Prior Approval" of the Commission to award 38 contracts for Goods, Works and Services in excess of the thresholds stipulated under Section 7 of the Schedule of Threshold (Reg. No.003).

Of the 38 requests for "No Objection" to award contracts that the Commission received during the FY under review, 34 or 89.4% were approved and 4 or 10.6% were queried.

The percentage of queried requests reports that there are still institutions who are not conducting their procurement activities in keeping with requirements of the PPCA.

Challenges

The Commission launched the monitoring visitation, but was however halted at the time due to inadequate support to the Commission from the National Budget to facilitate the monitoring of procurement activities done by PEs, thus, the Commission was unable to do a comprehensive and thorough review of the procurement activities conducted by PEs during the period under review.

Limited funding to the Commission to thoroughly monitor procurement activities and inspect procurement records continues to put appropriations allocated to PEs in the budget at risk.

In view of the foregoing, the Commission pinpoints the following challenges:

- ❖ Inadequate budget to conduct thorough review and assessment of procurement activities conducted by PEs;
- ❖ The unwillingness of some public procurement and concession granting entities to comply with the processes and procedures of the PPCA;
- ❖ Insufficient manpower to conduct compliance monitoring reviews, and
- ❖ Inadequate equipment/working tools such as laptop/computers and vehicles to conduct real-time inspection of procurement records.

Conclusion

Amidst the challenges confronting the Commission, the Commission was able to conduct routine inspection of procurement records of some PEs during the period under review.

Crucially, the compliance levels of Procuring Entities and concession granting entities to provisions of the PPC Act is gradually improving given the PPCC vigorous activities executed to convey the importance of abiding with procedures and processes. The Commission is convinced that with continued and full support from the GOL, the Compliance Monitoring activities of all procuring and concession granting entities will go a long way in raising the compliance level bars for Liberia.

The Commission states that the Government of Liberia should resonantly emphasize to all, that abidance of the PPCA by all procuring and concession granting entities be a priority in the acquisition of goods, works and services for the State. This is due to the fact that maximizing economy and efficiency in procurement, and obtaining best value for public expenditures, promoting economic development of the country; promoting integrity, accountability and public confidence in public procurement and concession processes are all attributes that ultimately contribute immensely to Liberia's National development.

Recommendations

The Commission remains optimistic that significant progress can be made in increasing public procurement and concessions compliance if the following are considered:

1. That the Commission is given adequate budget support to carry out its statutory mandates (Compliance Monitoring, Trainings, Logistics, etc...);
2. That the relocation or expansion of existing facilities of the Commission is considered paramount as Liberia contemplates migrating to eProcurement;
3. That opportunities for continued awareness trainings are made possible for public entities' procurement practitioners as well as private sector stakeholders, and
4. That opportunity for continued professional empowerment is made possible for staff of the Commission in relevant areas of studies to enhance their efficiency and proficiency.

Sections 27 (g) and 43 (9) of the PPCA require that Procuring Entities should furnish the Commission on a quarterly basis a report for monitoring and evaluation purposes of the contracts awarded during the preceding period.

For the reporting period under review, in accordance with the table above, of the one hundred and forty-five (145) procuring entities that received monies for goods and services in the 19/20 approved budget, only nine (9) or 6.2% of the total number of procuring entities submitted a report as required by Sections 27 (g) and 43 (9) of the PPCA for either one (1) of the four (4) quarters of the reporting period. This means that one hundred and thirty-six (136) or 93.8% of the Procuring Entities did not comply with the requirements of Sections 27 (g) and 43 (9) of the PPCA respectively.

It is worth mentioning that the failure of the non-compliant entities to submit their quarterly procurement reports as required denied the Commission the possibility of monitoring their compliance with the PPCA regarding the signing and awarding of contracts.
