

Following a thorough review, the Commission hereby approves the MoS's draft procurement plan for the fiscal year 2024 in accordance with Section 40 (3) of the PPCA, 2010, as well as the request to sole source CONEX Energy Liberia for the supply and delivery of petroleum products for the Office of the President at the estimated cost of US\$ 45,684.00 (Forty-Five Thousand Six Hundred Eighty-Four United States Dollars) in accordance with Section 55 (d) of the PPCA, 2010. The Commission further informs the MoS that the procurement plan will be duly forwarded to the Ministry of Finance and Development Planning (MFDP) and that the MFDP will process allotments in keeping with the approved procurement plan.
